- Student outcomes

Basic Science: Including but not limited to

- Research with various cell lines
- Biomechanics
- Pre-clinical models
- Development of novel software for basic science data analysis
- New drug development/Novel *Use*

*\*\*We consider research to be any projects involving scholarly work, educational development, exploratory work, and/or hypothesis testing.*

Accepted abstracts will be asked to be made into posters (or presentations) to be delivered at the symposium and will also be available on the Noorda COM website. A selection of the top-rated posters will be published in the Intermountain Journal of Translational Medicine.
